Seventy Customers Attend GP2010/Future of FRx Seminars

The seminar concluded with a joint presentation by Michael Newman and David Laster on the "Seven Steps to a Successful Upgrade." After a Q&A session, customers filed out with Panera lunch boxes and Dunkin' Donuts coffee.
